Early bird: \$12/run for entries received by March 8th at midnight

Regular Pricing: \$14/run for entries received by closing (March 31)

Day of Show: \$16/run (until trial fills) entries accepted at the trial only (not by email)

Note: To avoid any potential theft or loss (however remote), we deposit checks, in batches, as they are received before the closing date. Please plan accordingly and see our refund policy on p. 2: we will issue new checks for refunds of withdrawn entries originally paid via check.

Entries open:

When the premium is available

Entries close: March 27th, 2023, at 3pm

(Entries must be RECEIVED by this date/time)

Crating available:

Next to the ring (but not adjacent to the ring area) or out of your car. **Must have waterproof tarp under set-up.**

Entry Limits: 500 runs/day

Move ups:

Are allowed day to day. No same day move ups permitted.

Day of show entries:

If we do not reach our limit, we offer day-of-show entries at \$16 per run. **Please use our self-service drop-off box/envelop at the Trial Secretary's table** to leave your completed entry & payment before the Elite course is set.

Refunds:

A **100% refund** will be given for requests for withdrawals received **prior to the Closing Date**.

For exhibitors withdrawing after the closing date and before the trial starts, due to injury/illness of the dog or females in heat, the club will issue a refund less an administrative charge to cover NADAC and judge fees of \$3 per run. A note from a veterinarian will be required by Friday, November 25 at 6PM.

No refunds will be made in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Organizing Committee.

If you think you've been exposed to COVID-19 before or during the trial, please do not come to/come back to the trial! Email the trial secretary at ruffagilityofky@gmail.com for a refund. If in doubt, please do not come – we will gladly see you at the next trial!

To keep the trial running smoothly **we need EVERYONE to help**. We will have a worker sign-up for exhibitors to help. We will be glad to show you how to perform any job – just ask! When everyone helps, trials run very efficiently. If there is not enough help, the trial will run slowly and we will finish late. Workers are greatly appreciated.

Awards and Ribbons:

RuFF will offer ribbons for 1st through 4th places in each jump height for each class in each level, except Chances which is a Q/NQ class. A qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. **Please let us know (in advance) if you expect to earn a NATCH, V-NATCH, or Platinum NATCH** at the trial so we can celebrate with one of our special NATCH ribbons.

Equipment info:

Weave poles have 24" spacing. Hoops, wingless jumps, tunnels, and barrels. Electronic timers will be used.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable about NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but you cannot indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **RuFF Agility of KY (RuFF)** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and **Oldham County Family YMCA** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons

1.6 Exhibitor understands that they are responsible for their and their dogs conduct at both the show grounds and at the hotels and campgrounds during the entire weekend (Friday through Monday morning). Failure to comply can be a reason for dismissal from the trial; including no refund of monies and elimination of all scores obtained during the trial.

Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$50.

THE MANAGEMENT (RuFF and CEA) will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Communicating with the Trial Secretary:

Please contact the Trial Secretary via email only (RuffagilityofKY@gmail.com). Do **NOT** post on FaceBook and expect a response. Emails regarding the trial will be responded to within 3 days (and usually sooner). However, we are all volunteers and may unintentionally miss an email. If you send an email and do not receive a response within 3 days, please email again. **If you entered the trial but did not get an email confirmation by the end of the day Wednesday the week of the trial, please email the Trial Secretary ASAP.** We may have been unable to read the email address on your entry OR there might have been another error or mix-up. We have always been able to fix problems with entries but prefer to do so sooner, rather than later.

Completing the Entry Form:

Please make sure your email address is legible. All confirmations, show instructions, and results are sent via email. **If the Trial Secretary cannot read your email address, you will not receive a confirmation, your results, or any other correspondence!** If you have changed your email, mailing address, phone number, or any other information, please highlight this information when you submit your entry.

Entries must include payment. Entries received without payment will not be considered valid until payment is received. RuFF accepts check or PayPal (to ruffagilityofky@gmail.com). Cash is accepted for Day of Show entries in addition to these other forms of payment.

Regular entries close on the Monday before the trial when the Trial Secretary makes the last US mail pick-up and checks email at 3pm. Please plan appropriately when mailing/emailing your entries. All entries, including payments, must be received by this date or the Day of Show rate will apply.

RuFF Agility – Policies and Code of Conduct:

In addition to the NADAC rules listed and referenced in this premium, below is a brief summary of RuFF-specific rules.

- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$50.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Handlers caught not picking up after their dog may be asked to leave the show site and no refund will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.
- RuFF Agility does not permit bitches in any stage of their heat cycle in or near the arena. Any bitch in season must be kept in your vehicle for the duration of the trial. Contact a member of the show committee for specific instructions on where to park and walk your bitch. Please be considerate of your fellow competitors and leave bitches in season at home, if possible.

Please review RuFF's Code of Conduct policy posted at the Trial site for more information

Treats in Pocket in the Ring:

According to NADAC rules, during a trial, treats may be carried into the ring in the handler's pocket but must be in a sealed bag or small container. Handlers cannot indicate to their dog that they have this item on them (by patting their pocket, etc.). Handlers may not remove the container or feed their dog until they are at least 10 feet outside the ring. **Treats must remain "containerized" when not in use outside of the ring so that other dogs will not have access to their neighbors' goodies.**
